Bulgarian ATV Championship Rulebook: Key Regulations for Participants

Welcome to the official Rulebook for the Bulgarian ATV Championship! This guide outlines the rules and guidelines all participants must follow to ensure a fair, safe, and exciting competition.

Whether you're a seasoned racer or a newcomer, understanding these rules is essential for success.

1. Categories and Classes

The championship is divided into the following categories based on engine capacity and rider experience:

Super Mini Junior Class: 50cc.

Mini Junior Class: 90cc.

Junior Class: 250cc

ATV Pro Class: 450cc

2. Eligibility Criteria

✓ Riders must possess a valid racing license issued by the Bulgarian Motor Sports Federation (BMSF).

✓ All participants must submit proof of insurance and a medical certificate.

✓ Minors must provide parental or guardian consent.

3. ATV Technical Requirements

To ensure fair competition, all ATVs must adhere to the following:

- ✓ Engine Modifications: Limited to those permitted by the technical inspection committee.
- ✓ Safety Equipment: ATVs must have functional brakes, a kill switch, and approved tires.
- ✓ Noise Levels: Exhaust systems must comply with noise regulations as set by the BMSF.
- 4. Safety Gear
- ✓ All participants must wear:
- ✓ A certified helmet.
- ✓ Full-body protective gear, including gloves, boots, and chest protectors.
- ✓ Goggles to protect against debris.

5. Race Conduct

- ✓ Riders must follow the designated course without cutting corners.
- \checkmark Aggressive or unsportsmanlike behavior, such as intentional collisions, will result in disqualification.
- ✓ Assistance is allowed only in designated support areas.

6. Points and Scoring System

- ✓ Points are awarded based on finishing positions in each race.
- ✓ The champion in each class is determined by the highest cumulative score across all championship rounds.

7. Penalties and Appeals

✓ Violations of the rules may result in time penalties, disqualification, or suspension from future events.

- ✓ The Bulgarian ATV Championship promotes eco-friendly practices:
- ✓ Riders must avoid causing damage to natural landscapes.
- ✓ All participants and teams are required to dispose of waste responsibly.
- 9. Registration Process
- ✓ Registration forms and entry fees must be submitted before the official deadline.
- ✓ Late entries may be subject to additional charges or rejection.
